#### **Science Vocabulary Words**

- 1. **<u>boil/boiling:</u>** A change in form of matter from a liquid to a gas
- 2. <u>condense/condensing</u>: A change in form of matter from a gas to a liquid
- 3. <u>conductor</u>: A material used to transfer heat (electricity); heat will go through it easily
- 4. <u>evaporate/evaporation</u>: A change in form of matter from a liquid to a gas; happens slowly at the surface of the liquid
- 5. <u>freeze/freezing</u>: A change in form of matter from a liquid to a solid
- 6. <u>melt/melting</u>: A change in form of matter from a solid to a liquid
- 7. **insulator:** A material used to prevent the passage of heat (electricity); heat **will not** go through it easily
