WHAT DEDICATIION SHOULD MEAN TO PARENTS

Our church has two sacraments: The Lord's Supper and Baptism. These are central in Christian experience. But an observance of almost equal importance is Dedication because in the case of children born to believing parent, dedication normally precedes Baptism or participating in the Lord's Supper.

The dedication of children is a practice that has its origin in the Holy Scriptures. It is an expression of love for God and is a declaration on the part of the parent(s) to be a godly influence in the life of the child (Genesis 22:12; I Samuel 1:27-28; Matthew 19:13-15).

PARENTS TAKE VOWS

It is the parents who assume the responsibility for Christian upbringing and for this reason the parents take vows. In presenting your child for Christian dedication at River of Life Church you are declaring your concern for the spiritual well being of this child and you are expressing your purpose to lead him/her in the way of Jesus Christ.

THE CONGREGATION TAKES A VOW

Furthermore, your child also becomes a special responsibility of the body of Christ. It is our responsibility to receive your child into the nurture of this church and to do our part in leading him/her to a Jesus-centred life in every way possible.

FAMILIES AT CHURCH

It is important for us to know that you, as a parent(s), are taking the time to understand the vows, that you are committed to the vows and that you have a plan for carrying them out. Carrying out the obligation of the vows involves instructing your child in the faith into which he or she has been dedicated and also includes family attendance at church on a consistent basis.

Our duty before God is to allow you to take vows that you are sincerely prepared to keep, to the best of your ability and with God's help, after the dedication ritual is passed.

GUIDELINES

As you prepare to complete the request form, the child dedication guidelines of ROL are:

- 1. Membership at ROL on the part of the parent(s) is not essential to the dedication of a child but regular attendance for a minimum of three months is.
- 2. At least one parent should be a follower of Christ, having trusted Jesus Christ for salvation.
- 3. Dedications will be scheduled by the Pastoral Care Coordinator after receiving the request form.
- 4. Two options are available venues for dedications:
 - a. In the Cell Group setting by the cell group leader in which the family is attending; *or*
 - b. In the sanctuary during a Sunday morning service by a pastor assigned to dedication.
- 5. Meet with the dedicating pastor before the scheduled dedication time.
