Dear Parents/Guardians,

Following the success of previous year's ski trip, we will be running a further two trips next year. The upper school trip for current years 9 to 12 will take place at Sunday River, USA. The resort offers excellent accommodation, skiing and evening entertainment.

The provisional cost of the trip is £1075 which includes the following:

- Coach Travel and air travel
- Insurance
- Breakfast and evening meal
- Boot, helmet and Ski hire
- Lift pass
- 5 days skiing for 4 hour lessons
- Taxes
- A city stop over in Boston

Additional Costs/information

- Dry Ski Slope lessons to take place between November and February. Approx. cost £35.
- In the event of an insurance claim, parents will be responsible for the excess, approx. £35.
- Evening entertainment approximate cost £25 payable in resort
- The school reserves the right to withdraw any student whose school behaviour makes it inappropriate for them to attend a school trip. In this case no refund will be made. By signing the form attached you are agreeing to this condition. Students leaving the school prior to departure will also lose their place and monies.
- Hire/purchase of appropriate clothing.
- Students will need approximately \$9 for lunch each day

The provisional departure date is 2nd April returning on the 10th April, 2012. The resort has a good snow record for this time of year.

If you would like to reserve a place on the trip for your son/daughter please return the slip below at your earliest convenience and a £100 deposit no later than 29th April. In the event that we have too many students names will be drawn from a hat. Please return the slip below to reserve a place by 10th February followed by the deposit no later than 29th April.

Instalments will be due in 3 stages:

29th May £350 30th September £350 25th November £275

If you choose to pay by cheque please ensure that the student's name, form and the name of the Trip/Activity are clearly written on the back of the cheque, which should be made payable to 'St Crispin's School'.

If paying by cash it must be in a sealed envelope with the students name, form, amount enclosed, Trip/Activity clearly written on the outside.

This trip is an optional visit and the school asks that the payment is made as a voluntary contribution to cover the cost. In the event that we are unable to cover the costs the trip may have to be cancelled. If you are experiencing difficulty in paying for this visit a written request for support should be submitted to the school bursar. In the event that the visit is oversubscribed names will be drawn from a hat from all those that have replied by the deadline.
