### PRE-CONFERENCE REQUIREMENTS

Students who are selected to attend the conference must attend a mandatory pre-trip meeting on Thursday, March 4<sup>th</sup> from 12:00 – 1:30 PM. This meeting will be held with the staff trip leader and will cover trip conduct expectations, travel and logistics, more about what to expect at the conference, and detailed information about the post-conference requirements.

### POST-CONFERENCE REQUIREMENTS

Students attending the LLN Conference will be required to complete 3 activities during the Spring 2010 semester to share their knowledge and experience from the conference. 1) Students will each create a small display board showing what they learned, which will be hung on display during the Spring semester. 2) Students will participate in a Lunch Discussion on Tuesday, March 30 from 12:00 – 1:30 PM with LMC President Peter Garcia and staff/faculty to talk about their conference experience and what they learned. 3) Students will create and give a 15-20 min. group presentation on their experience and what they learned to the Puente English-100 class on Thursday, April 1 from 9:30 – 10:00 AM.
