- 5) I understand that susceptibility from SOC potential contaminant sources or activities will be determined by the Source Water Assessment contaminant source inventory. I also understand that if potential contaminant sources or activities are found within the WRA, I will be given an opportunity to verify their presence before the renewal application is denied;
- 6) I understand that if the renewal application is denied, the application fee will not be refunded and that subsequent monitoring for synthetic organic chemicals will be required.
