## Swisher/ Matesky Piano Scholarship

This scholarship was established to assist students who wish to pursue degrees and/or careers in music with an emphasis on piano. Through the generosity of donors, the Shoreline Community College Foundation is making available two \$1,500 scholarships to students who plan to study at Shoreline Community College during the 2014 - 2015 year and meet the eligibility criteria. The awards will be for SCC tuition and/or fees.

The scholarship has no cash exchange value and is non-transferable. The award expires spring 2015.

## Criteria for Eligibility

- ❖ Applicant must be a U.S. citizen or legal U.S. resident or permanent U.S. resident with an I-551 card or a student in F-1 nonimmigrant status.
- ❖ Applicant must have applied to SCC or be a currently enrolled student in the SCC music department.
- ❖ Applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or better in all music courses.
- ❖ Applicant must plan to be enrolled at SCC in a minimum of 9 credits/quarter during the upcoming school year.
- Applicant must enroll in 2 credits of MUSC 180/280 each quarter the award is available.

## **Application Procedures**

To be considered, each applicant must submit 3 copies of the following: (Please type)

- 1. Completed application form.
- 2. Copy of most recent transcripts (un-official is OK).
- 3. Current class schedule
- 4. Copy of Permanent U.S. Resident (I-551) Card or passport, I-20 & I-94 documents (if appliciable).
- 5. Resume of musical activities.
- 6. One page essay describing your career goals and the role the piano plays in these goals.
- 7. A letter of recommendation from a piano instructor (current or former).

Scholarship funds will be available for use beginning fall quarter 2014. Awards are not transferable and must be used at Shoreline Community College. The funds will be disbursed in three equal installments for fall, winter and spring quarters. The student must be enrolled in 2 credits of MUSC 180/280 each quarter in order to receive their quarterly disbursement.
