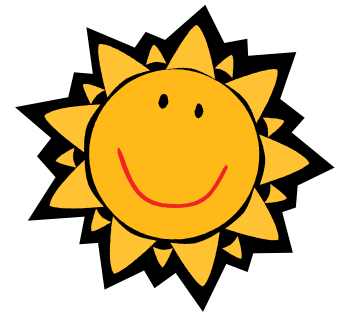


Northwood Summer Bridge Program

- A lottery system will be used in the event that we have more children registered for a camp than spaces available.

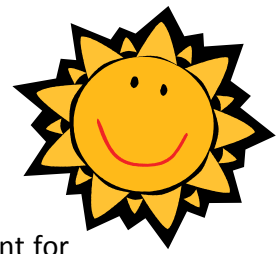
