NOTE: Scholarship funds will be awarded to the student upon evidence of registration and acceptance in an accredited post- secondary institution.

Purpose: To provide scholarships to THREE (3) deserving high school graduating seniors interested in or intending to pursue post – high school course of study at either college/ university or other post – secondary educational institution.

Award Components: Three scholarships, denominations of \$999.99, \$499.99 and \$299.99, and individual certificates awarded to the students selected by the 99¢ Only Stores Scholarship Committee. - 3. Three (3) letters of recommendation from choice of high school teachers, administrators, counselors, employers, or individuals with significant knowledge of applicant's experience and involvement.
- 4. An official and recent high school transcript with cumulative grade point average and a class standing/ rank.

How have you made a positive difference, and how will accomplishing your educational goals help facilitate a greater difference?
