Parent and Student Informed Consent Form

(CHS Graduation Requirement – Class of 2015)

As the parent/guardian of _____, a student attending Curtis High School at University Place School District, I am aware that he/she must complete the volunteer service requirement, as part of his/her graduation requirements. I understand my son/daughter will participate in activities that include a volunteer service component.

I understand the required volunteer service must be completed with a non-profit organization, which is listed in detail on the "Volunteer Service Requirement" attached to this consent form.

I understand that the University Place School District will not have staff present during any outside preparation of activities involved in the volunteer service. I assume the responsibility of supervising my son/daughter for all the activities involved in coordinating the volunteer service.

I understand that the District prohibits a student from undertaking any activity, which may place the student and/or his or her supervisors at an unnecessary risk of harm or injury. I understand that the District expects the parent/guardian to make the initial determination as to whether a volunteer service activity places the student and/or his or her supervisors at risk of harm or injury. I understand that it is the responsibility of the parent(s)/guardians(s) to ensure the supervisor is: 1) providing their son or daughter with a safe environment, and 2) following all necessary safety procedures.

Being fully informed and aware of the risks associated with this volunteer service activity, I/we hereby give my permission for my son/daughter, _____, to participate. I release the University Place School District and assume any risk inherent in the activity. In addition, I waive the right of recovery or to bring legal action against the University Place School District for any injury, death, property damage or other consequences arising out of participation or during the period of this activity.
