FIREMAN LO-PRESSURE:%  • Tends to boilers with less than 15 psi (steam heat).  • Fireman's Class II license required.		
• Performs repair of heating and boiler equipment. Regulates steam pressure and heating system controls.		
<ul> <li>APPLIANCE PERSON:%</li> <li>Performs repairs to large and small electrical appliances and equipment. Uses diagnostic test devices.</li> <li>Knowledge of electrical circuitry required.</li> </ul>		
<ul> <li>AUTO MECHANIC:%</li> <li>Performs repair and overhaul of automotive vehicles using tools and test equipment to diagnose hydraulic, electrical, mechanical, and ignition systems.</li> <li>Interprets automotive manuals and electrical schematics.</li> </ul>
