GENERAL INFORMATION

The Northrop Rice Foundation is pleased to announce the availability of aviation scholarships for instructors and students of Approved PART 147 Aviation Technician Schools that are members of the Northrop Rice Foundation, and for honorably discharged veterans who are preparing to take the Federal Aviation Administration written examinations for certification as Aviation Maintenance Technicians (A&P). These scholarships are funded by donations made to the Foundation by several aviation organizations that are supporting the Foundation's efforts to assist young people who are entering or are about to enter the Aviation Industry. The scholarships available are the NRF Instructor Assistance Program, NRF Student Tuition Program, NRF Veteran Book Award, and the NRF Outstanding Student of the Year Award.

APPLICATION PROCEDURES AND REQUIREMENTS

PART 147 SCHOOL STUDENTS

PART 147 Aviation Maintenance Training School students must file a NRF Student Application and provide the information and documentation requested on the application. These funds are to be used for tuition assistance and are in the maximum amount of \$1,000.00 per year. Deadline for submitting applications is January 31.

PART 147 SCHOOL INSTRUCTORS

PART 147 Aviation Maintenance Training School instructors must file a NRF Instructor Application and provide the information and documentation requested on the NRF Instructor Application. These funds are to be used to cover the travel and per diem expenses for instructors attending short-term upgrading training. Documented expenses up to \$1,000.00 are covered by this scholarship. Deadline for submitting applications is January 31.

VETERANS OF US MILITARY FORCES AVIATION BRANCHES

This scholarship is intended to assist honorably discharged veterans with military aviation maintenance experience who are planning to apply for the Federal Aviation Administration certification as Aviation Maintenance Technicians (A&P). This scholarship is available to veterans who qualify to sit for the FAA Airframe and/or Powerplant written examinations. This scholarship will cover the cost of reference text books, study guides, Federal Air Regulations, and mechanic's handbook for either or both written examinations. Applications for this scholarship will be accepted on a continuing basis.
