DEFERRED PAYMENT PLAN

GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS

- Submit an "Application for Deferred Payment Plan" each semester to the FVCC Business Office, 777 Grandview Drive, Kalispell, MT 59901. If you fax (406-756-3815) an application, please provide us with the original including an ORIGINAL STUDENT SIGNATURE. A hold may be placed on the student's account until the original form is received in the Business Office.
- 2. A minimum payment of at least one-quarter of the total charges due for the semester must be paid by the payment due date. All available financial aid credited to your account will reduce your monthly payment schedule. Please note: For priority early registered students the payment due date is 10 days before the start of classes. For those registering during general registration, the first payment is due at the time of registration.
- 3. Scheduled Payments as well as any other outstanding charges due Flathead Valley Community College are to be paid at the Business Office, 777 Grandview Drive, Kalispell, MT 59901, either via web, mail, fax, or in person. Any payments that are mailed must be RECEIVED by the Business Office on or before the scheduled due date. In case of default or delinquency in the repayment of all or any part of a scheduled installment, a late charge of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) shall be assessed against each late installment.
