CONTENT & ORGANISATION	(✓)
Focused on the topic.	
Organized to show a logical, systematic progression of ideas which are fully developed.	
Good synthesis of appropriate sources/ Sources used appropriately	
Ideas are fully developed with adequate support.	
Does not include any irrelevant information or repetition	
Well-structured with clear introduction, development and conclusion	
DELIVERY	
Fluent, well thought out delivery.	
Language and pronunciation very easy to follow - only minor errors.	
Uses a variety of grammatical structures that are complex enough for the topic.	
Speech is easily followed – not oo quick, not too slow.	
Voice is audible with appropriate intonation.	
Confident, smooth speech with very natural delivery	
Good use of body language.	
Attracts listener's attention.	
Language & pronunciation errors do not impede communication.	
No hesitation at all.	
Speaking is not monotonous or fragmented.	
Notes either not understood or referred to continually [reads from the notes all the time]..	
Good timing – not too long, not too short.	
VISUAL AIDS

VOCABULARY	
Sophisticated and extensive range of vocabulary for the level that allows for full discussion.

PERSONALITY	
Apparent confidence with no hesitation.	
Conveys a positive attitude to the listeners.	
Appropriate eye contact with the listeners.
