Camp attire

Campers should wear comfortable clothing, and bring shoes suitable for hiking (tennis shoes or sturdy hiking sandals) and the beach (slippers). They should have a change of clothing with them, a towel, a HAT and a swimsuit every day. Campers who sunburn should also bring sunblock with them, please make sure you apply sunblock at home each morning if you know your child easily burns, we will be in the sun every day.

Lunch

Snacks are provided for all campers.

All campers must bring a cold lunch that does not require heating and a beverage.

WATER BOTTLES should also be with your camper every day! We will be doing outside activities and your camper needs to have plenty of water and a healthy lunch.
