We made our own play dough one afternoon recently. The kids asked me to share the recipe.

Play Dough

1 cup Flour

1/2 cup Salt

2 teaspoons Cream of Tartar

2 Tablespoons Vegetable Oil

1 cup water and a few drops of food coloring

Mix all ingredients well in a medium saucepan. Cook, stirring with a wooden spoon, over medium heat until dry enough to form a ball. Turn out onto wax paper to cool. Knead to mix color if needed. Store in zip-lock bag for up to 3 months. Have fun!!
