How to use your card

When you arrive at Park and Ride:

- Take a ticket on entry to raise the barrier.
- Park your car in one of the bays provided.
- Insert the ticket in the pay station located at the terminus; this can be done before or after using the Park and Ride bus service.
- Enter your Park and Ride card as payment.
- Take your validated ticket and card.

When you leave:

■ Insert your ticket into the exit station to raise the barrier and leave the site.

Conditions of use

Do not leave your card on your vehicle dashboard as it may be damaged by the heat.

- 1. You must use this card in line with the current Canterbury City Council (Off Street Parking Places) Order, which you can see at the Council Offices, Military Road, Canterbury.
- 2. Card holders are responsible for the safe keeping of their cards. The city council will not accept responsibility for damaged or corrupted cards nor for the 'loss' of any value held on cards lost or as a result of damage or corruption.
- 3. We may introduce changes to charges at any time. However, these are usually only introduced from April each year.
- 4. Any misuse of a Park and Ride card will be subject to not only the cancellation of the card but possible legal proceedings.
- 5. **Refunds** We can only process a minimum refund of £30 less £10 administration charge.
