Young Artists' Conference Workshops – 2013

- Secwepemc Pine Needle Baskets Using local gathered supplies from the
 mountains, students will complete a small pine needle basket with their own personal
 touch. If you like nature, this is a craft that smells fresh while you are making it and
 makes a beautiful gift or keepsake.
- 2. **Beginners Beading Workshop** Come and learn basic beading techniques to create a beautiful flower in a traditional Métis flowerette style. A great gift for Mother's Day.
- 3. **Polymer Clay Portrait** The artists from 4-Cats Artist Studio are excited to present a self portrait workshop using polymer clay on an acrylic painted canvas board.
- 4. <u>Painting with Karla</u> Join local artist Karla Pearce in a step by step visual instructional leading students through the process of creating an acrylic landscape painting on canvas.
- 5. <u>Lettering as an ART: Calligraphy</u> Introduction of the board lettering nib, the class will move about to stations giving each participant a glimpse of this beautiful world with music to inspire your creative juices. Small take home projects.
- 6. **Ships, Suitcases, and Tunnels!** What does a ship, a suitcase, and a tunnel have in common? They can all be made into book shapes! Come and create delightfully different book structures to house your creative writing and your drawings! You will be amazed!
- 7. <u>Bedazzled!</u> Have you ever seen a kaleidoscope in a store, or played with one at home? Light shines through the coloured beads and creates an ever-changing beautiful pattern when you twist the tube. Learn to make your own kaleidoscope with PVC pipe, a petri dish, mirrors, coloured beads, and various decorative materials. Not only will it look great decorated with your own personal style, but it will also create constantly changing designs.
- 8. Whimsical Watercolour Join us in this workshop as we explore creative approaches to painting with watercolour. Blow, spatter, resist and dab your way into visually exciting artworks!
- 9. <u>Shattered Pictures</u> Learn the ancient art of mosaics while designing and creating a unique mosaic picture. Come with a picture in your mind of what Spring means to you and learn how to interpret that into glass, glue, and grout.
- 10. <u>Krazy Kites</u> Learn how to make amazing Delta Wing fabric kites. We will design, construct and decorate these super flyers and then head out to test them if time permits!
