1. What are the key factors that would affect levee performance to be covered in the 2012 Plan?
2. What are the primary categories of existing problems and expected future challenges related to levee performance within the study area?
3. What are the available documents to use as reference material related to levee performance problems, opportunities, and standards (in addition to what has already been provided to the Non Urban Levee Evaluations (NULE) and AB156 programs)?
4. What are other levee performance evaluation activities that the 2012 Plan should consider (in addition to what is being considered under the NULE and AB156 programs)?

The Levee Performance Scope Definition Work Group will be limited to a maximum of 25 people to allow for efficient facilitated dialogue and interaction. The California Department of Water Resources (DWR) seeks group members who will represent a broad range of interests and perspectives. Work group members will be selected by DWR.
