Information Sheet for FEI CEI*(50-mile) & CEI** (80-mile) Entries

Event registration: Those competing in the FEI division must fill out and mail in both an AERC entry (send to ride manager Patsy Gowen; form at www.aerc.org) and a separate FEI entry to FEI event manager Mary Howell (entry available at www.usasoutheastendurance.com or by contacting Mary at 804.432.0236 or countshiloh@gmail.com).

Host Facility: This event will be held at H. Cooper Black Recreation Area, 279 Sporting Dog Trail, Cheraw, SC 29520. HCB offers 27 campsites with electricity and water, as well as bath houses with hot showers, an RV dump station and primitive camping. Horses competing in the FEI division must either be stabled in the H. Cooper Black barn or penned in a designated primitive camping area located in the large field on the far side of the arena. FEI horses will NOT be allowed next to the electric campsites or metal pole corrals on the front side of basecamp, so plan accordingly.

We encourage you to make stall/campsite reservations in advance – the best time to contact the park staff is 11 a.m.-12 noon EST by calling **843.378.1555**; they can answer your questions and let you know what sites are still available.

Upon arrival at camp, please pay camping and stall fees directly to H. Cooper Black (their office is located in the H. Cooper Black horse barn and is staffed during weekday hours and also the Saturday of our event.) You can also purchase bagged cedar shavings, ice and cold drinks. If you arrive after hours, please make payment the following morning. Please note that stalls, if used, must be completely cleaned and stripped before departure.

Schedule: Riders may begin checking in at 1 pm on Friday October 18, 2013. The first veterinary inspection for FEI division horses and riders will begin at 2 p.m. Vetting for horses entered in the AERC division will begin at 3p.m. All horses entered in the FEI division must be registered, weighed and vetted by 5 p.m.; please contact FEI manager Mary Howell at 804.432.0236 or countshiloh@gmail.com if you will be arriving late or can't attend last minute. The ride briefing will begin at 6 p.m., followed by dinner which is included in the ride entry fee. Coffee and breakfast breads will be provided on ride morning, but otherwise no meals will be provided on ride day. Awards may be picked up after 4 p.m. on Saturday and the formal awards ceremony for 120km FEI competitors will be held at 8 a.m. on Sunday. (Best condition judging for both distances will be Saturday, 1 hour after the horse's completion time for Top Ten finishers in each distance. Awards for the 88km event will be in conjunction with AERC awards Sat. evening)

Awards: Becky Pearman will be our ride photographer and will be providing ride photos as completion awards; please contact her at cowgirgoof@aol.com if you wish to make portrait arrangements in advance (excellent for Christmas cards!) In addition to Best Condition and First to Finish awards in the two FEI divisions, a special award (in memory of Kathy Brunjes and her accomplishments on Ali Darkness and Theatric) will be given to the first rider on a chestnut mare or gelding to complete the 120 km (80-mile) distance.

Terrain: SanThe first vet check for the both FEI rides will be away from camp, and ride management will take drop bags for those without crew (please bring bags to ride meeting on Friday night; we will have hay, water and beet pulp available for all horses at this hold and ample water stops will be provided on trail. All remaining vet checks will be held in camp.
