## EACH CANDIDATE MUST MEET THE FOLLOWING REQUIREMENTS:

- The following are NMAA sanctioned sports: Baseball, Basketball, Cross Country, Football, Golf, Soccer, Softball, Spirit, Swimming/Diving, Tennis, Track & Field, Volleyball and Wrestling.
- Candidate must be a graduating senior who actively participated in *one* of the above activities during his/her sophomore and junior years of high school, and a minimum of *two* his/her senior year.
- Candidate must have a GPA of at least 3.0.
- Candidate's official high school transcript must be submitted.
- Candidate's official ACT and/or SAT score(s) must be submitted.
- APPLICANTS must submit a one page personal statement addressing how involvement in Athletics impacted his/her high school career.
- NOMINATORS must submit a one page statement addressing the candidate's worthiness of this award.
- A recent photograph or clear snapshot (wallet size) of the candidate must be submitted and may be used for promotion.
- At least three letters of recommendation must be submitted. One must be from a candidate's coach/sponsor, and one must be from a candidate's teacher
- Candidate must graduate from high school during the year of application and begin college the following fall semester.
- Applicants wishing to be considered for a need based scholarships must include their FAFSA report in the application packet.

### TIPS ON COMPLETING THE APPLICATION/NOMINATION PACKET

- 1. Read the requirements listed to the left carefully.
- 2. Be sure to fill out the application/nomination form completely.
- 3. Applications/nominations must <u>be received</u> in the NMAA office **NO LATER THAN** <u>February 3, 2012</u>.
- 4. Mail all materials together to insure that all information is received.
- 5. Incomplete application/nomination packets will not be considered.
