

#### Sisto-Garage Owner Submitted by: Larry Mundy ANGELO SISTO:GARAGE OWNER

During the 1915-1920 period, 1917 specifically, Angelo Sisto bought a garage at 48 Main Street. Angelo Sisto was born in Italy in 1886, the son of Louie and Christine Santucci Sisto. He came to the United States at age thirteen (13) in 1899. The family settled at Sayre, Pennsylvania, where Angelo's father worked for the Lehigh Valley Railroad. Angelo, also, spent time in the shops of the Lehigh Railroad (1899-1904). At the end of the five (5) year period, he established a retail grocery business in Waverly, New York. Two (2) years later, in 1907, he became a traveling salesman for the Wolverine Soap Company of Portland, Michigan, and, in 1915 came to Corning, New York; opened a wholesale grocery store and opened the Corning Lumber Yard. Harld Tobey and Elmer Edsall managed those businesses. He came to Addison in June of 1917 as proprietor of the Metro garage located at 45 Main Street. In 1920, he built a car show room next door at 47 Main Street.

Angelo Sisto, while operating the garage, six months later, bought the American Hotel, and during the following eleven years, was, also, the owner and manager of the American Hotel (1918-1929). In 1923, he made a visit to Italy with his wife Irene, and upon returning, purchased four gasoline and oil service stations, which he successfully operated until 1930, at which time, he disposed of his interests to the Shell Oil Company. That year, 1923. Also, Angelo Sisto bought Bert Cheeseman's

house on South Street. Cheeseman went to Mansfield, Pennsylvania as foreman for the Dairymen's League plant there.  $\,\,$  Upon return from Italy in March of 1923, Sisto expanded his garage. He had forty (40) cars and \$15,000-\$20,000 investment. In April of 1926, he erected a large garage addition at the back of his garage and to the south in back of the American House on the site of the former Albert P. Hill Livery Stables. Insurance rates prohibited him from building the addition on the near (north side of the American Hotel. The new addition gave him storage for thirty (30) cars and was heated separate from the American House. In June of 1926, Sisto was given an option on the Chatfield Sales Room ( along Main Street to the driveway along the building occupied by the N.Y.S. Electric Corporation and the Addison Radio Company. ?????). It was a twelve thousand (\$12,000 to \$15,000 ) investment. The building was made of concrete, brick, and cobblestone.







## **Summary of Jasper-Troupsburg Board of Education Meeting**

July 5, 2012

This summary is intended to help the Board and the Superintendent inform the community of the Jasper-Troupsburg School District about the issues the district is addressing. If anyone has a question or concern, please feel free to contact Chad C. Groff, Superintendent (792-3675).

Board Member Action. The following 2012-13 offices were elected for the board of education: President -Cameron Bullock, and Vice-President - Lisa Tracy. The Board also approved numerous official appointments that are part of the reorganization meeting. The list of appointments is located on the agenda posted on the website for the meeting.

Communications. Mrs. Catherine Robinson thanked the Board for their well wishes as she retires. Mr. Greg Elliot, GST BOCES Food Service, shared information related to school meal pricing changes that will face school districts. School districts will need to begin to adjust prices to meet federal guidelines. This information can be found in the front of the board packet information posted on the school website.

Presentation. Mr. Greg Elliot talked about the mandated changes regarding how school meal menus are created, what food items are served to students and the serving sizes by grade level, the whole grain content of certain foods, minimums and maximums for meats and grains, flavored milk requirements, and sodium levels. All these changes will be challenging for our staff as well as some of our taste buds - please be patient as we adjust to the new requirements.

Personnel items. The following staff were appointed for transportation services for special education summer school: Mrs. Patricia Young - bus driver; Mrs. Sandra Mattison - bus driver; Mrs. Amy Hammond - bus attendant; and Mr. Robert Cornish bus attendant. As our new high school guidance counselor transitions into her new position, the Board approved Mrs. Kathy Linnan to work with her during the summer transition.

Action items. The Board approved the athletic event fee schedule for the 2012-13 school year: same household family pass - \$25; single person pass - \$15; and a per person gate fee of \$1.00. Information related to purchasing athletic passes will be available in mid-August.

Discussion items. The Board continued its discussion of the future of the school house. After analyzing the historical costs and revenue for the house the Board decided it would explore the deed history for the house to be sure there are no requirements related to the potential sale of the house. In the meantime, the Board did not want the house to sit vacant during the winter months. Therefore, the Board decided to make the house available for a monthly rent of \$600. The lease agreement will also stipulate the potential for the district to sell the house in the future.
