APPLYING FOR A SOCIAL SECURITY NUMBER (SSN)

Currently the Social Security Administration issues SSN for international students on F-1 or J-1 visas for employment purposes <u>ONLY</u>.

- A completed Form SS-5 (this form is available at the SSA office)
- At least two documents that establish your age and identity (e.g. passport, driver's license, school ID).
