Application form partial tuition fee waiver

The basic fee

The standard Leiden University tuition fee for non-EU Archaeology students is €13.750 per academic year. This is the basic fee for all non-EU Archaeology students arriving in September 2008.

Grants for excellent students

Leiden University is committed to both recruiting and developing talent. Therefore, the Faculty of Archaeology has decided to provide grants for excellent students.

Students who received an overall average during their Bachelor education of an 8 (on scale of 1 to 10) or higher, can apply for a 'scholarship of excellence'. The scholarships for Master students (MA) amounts to € 3000,00 at maximum. For Research Master students (MPhil), the scholarship is € 5000,00. The scholarship should be considered as a partial tuition fee waiver.

Please note that students who finish their MA study in one year (12 months) with a good average grade (an 8 at minimum on a scale 1 to 10) will receive a bonus of excellence of € 1000,00.

Procedure of application for a 'scholarship of excellence'

Students who are willing to apply for a 'scholarship of excellence' can only do so by using the '**Scholarship of excellence**' application form.

The application form, accompanied by one copy of the BA-thesis, should be received by the Faculty of Archaeology Board of Application at least two months before the student will start their studies at Leiden University (so before the 1st of July or the 1st of December of each academic year).

The Board of Application will decide on the students' eligibility for the waiver within one month after receiving the application and will communicate their decision to the applicant by e-mail.

NB: All negotiations of fee are under the responsibility of the International Office of Leiden University.
