HMI has three integral components: a rigorous academic program involving an honorsand AP-level curriculum; a wilderness program that includes three extended backpacking trips; and our residential life program in Leadville, Colorado. HMI Summer Term The HMI Summer Term is a six-week summer program for rising sophomores, juniors, and seniors that combines place-based academic courses with an extensive leadership development curriculum. The program includes two wilderness trips in the Colorado Rockies that allow students to continue their academic studies, develop community and practice their leadership skills. ☐ HMI Gap The HMI Gap is a 12-week semester spent exploring the rugged Rocky Mountains and wild Patagonia by foot and on rock. The semester combines outdoor educational activities with an emphasis on backcountry wilderness skills and rock climbing, international travel and cultural exploration, environmental field studies, and service-learning opportunities in collaboration with scientists and land managers. Students live and travel within a small, close-knit group of their peers and faculty.
