

This professional, 2-day course teaches students how to determine the optimal insulation thickness and corresponding energy and dollar savings for a project. It also teaches skills in the following areas:

- Interviewing customers
- Conducting a facility walk-through
- Using the 3E Plus® Version 4.0 software
- Determining the amount of greenhouse gases saved through insulation
- Analyzing and completing the appraisal spreadsheet
- Completing and presenting a final customer report

This certification will be valid for 3 years, after which the individual must recertify. All NIA member certified appraisers are listed on NIA's website. 


