



Application for Conditional Admission International Students From Saudi Arabia

This information and application forms package can be used by students from Saudi Arabia seeking admission to both English language studies and undergraduate degree studies at the University of Guelph.

University of Guelph

The University of Guelph has earned a place of distinction among Canada's Universities, receiving national acclaim for its leadership in innovation, its outstanding faculty and its excellence in educating the leaders of tomorrow. At Guelph we provide a wide range of high quality, prestigious programs to 16,878 full-time undergraduate students and 2,163 graduate students. Our beautiful 330-hectare (817 acre) park-like campus is a wonderful setting within which to live and study. English Language Certificate Program at University of Guelph

The English Language Certificate Program (ELCP) is an English for Academic Purposes (EAP) program for English as a second language (ESL) students who plan to enter undergraduate or graduate studies at a Canadian university. The ELCP is offered through the Office of Open Learning, the unit responsible for extending University of Guelph's educational resources nationally and internationally.

The ELCP program is divided into ten levels, ranging from beginner to advanced. Students are placed into the appropriate levels based on an evaluation of their current English proficiency. Levels 1 to 8 are comprised of seven-week terms, with 5 courses per term. Six terms are offered each academic year, with entry points in January, March, May, July, September and November. The Advanced Level courses (Levels 9 & 10) are completed in one 14 week block.







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Admission for Saudi Arabian Students

Students will be considered for conditional admission to the University of Guelph if they present:

- 1. The National Secondary School Education/Leaving Certificate (Tawjihiyah) with excellent results overall and in required subjects
- 2. Proof of eligibility for a Saudi Arabian government scholarship
- 3. Documents verified by the Saudi Arabian Cultural Bureau in Ottawa, bearing the stamp and seal of the Bureau and sent directly in sealed envelopes addressed to the University of Guelph
- 4. A declaration of activity during gaps in study by completing the attached Activities Form
- 5. An accompanying application to the English Language Certificate Program at the University of Guelph with the intention of completing the Advanced Level (Levels 9 & 10) in good standing prior to August 2011

ESL Admission

Note: Students transferring from another university or college of higher education may be considered for admission into the English Language Certificate Program on a case by case basis based on program availability. Transfer students will be required to send official transcripts of studies from both the high school and university/college level to mailing address noted on following page. Course descriptions may also be requested.

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Application Process

Application for conditional admission is a two step process that includes both the application to Undergraduate Admissions and the application to the English Language Certificate Program. Completed applications are sent to the Office of Open Learning at the address noted below. All communication regarding the application process should also be directed to the OOL.

The full application package requires the following:

- 1) ESL program application consisting of:
 - a. Application form
 - b. Application fee
 - c. Scholarship letter
 - d. ALTE (Association of Language Testers in Europe) Self-assessment of language skills
 - e. Head and shoulders photograph
 - f. Passport copy of identity pages
 - g. Transcripts may be scanned and emailed or faxed
- 2) Undergraduate Admission application consisting of:
 - a. Application form
 - b. Application fee paid by credit card Note: Applications can not be processed without this fee
 - c. Scholarship letter
 - d. Official transcripts with final three years, translated into English, sealed and sent directly from the student's secondary school or Ministry of Education OR attested by the Saudi Arabian Cultural Bureau in Ottawa and sent directly in a sealed envelope addressed to the Office of Open Learning
 - e. Explanation of gaps in education (if necessary) provided by filing in the attached Activities Form
 - f. Choice of one of the six appendix program options




