# Did you know that the due date for 2010 individual federal income tax returns will be Monday, April 18, 2011?

#### So what's the deal?

In 2011, Washington, D.C., will celebrate Emancipation Day on April 15, a day earlier than normal, since April 16 falls on a Saturday. Emancipation Day marks the anniversary of the day that President Lincoln signed the Compensated Emancipation Act. The Act, which was "for the release of certain persons held to service or labor in the District of Columbia," freed 3,100 slaves in the District, making DC residents the "first freed" by the federal government. In 2005, Emancipation Day was made an official public holiday in the District of Columbia.

In observance of the DC holiday, Tax Day will be moved forward one business day, this year landing it on Monday, April 18. That's the date your form has to be either submitted electronically or postmarked by for your tax return to be considered timely filed by the IRS.

Don't be fooled into believing that the day moves all individual federal income tax deadlines forward. The overseas exception due date will still be June 15, 2011. However, individual federal income tax returns on a "normal" extension will be due on Monday, Oct.17, 2011; that's because Oct. 15, 2011, (the regular extension due date) falls on a Saturday.

#### **The Other Chambers of Commerce**

The recent political conflict between the Obama Administration and the U.S. Chamber of Commerce has thrown a new spotlight on an old communication problem. Local chambers of commerce, although they predate the U.S. Chamber by nearly a century and a half, often are assumed to be part of the U.S. Chamber, or otherwise under its direction. They aren't. They are independent.

During the pre-election controversy this year, it was clear that many people, including many chamber members, did not know this fact. They believe that U.S. Chamber President Tom Donohue and his colleagues on H Street directly or indirectly control all that local chambers do. But Donohue and his staff don't exercise such control, nor do they want to. Few people think about what chambers do locally.

For example, who knows that Elliot Tiber, president of the Bethel, N.Y., Chamber of Commerce, secured the permit for Woodstock? It was also a local chamber – the Business Men's League of Atlantic City – that came up in 1920 with the idea of a festival to keep tourists in town after Labor Day.

Pretty women in beachwear would turn out to be the centerpiece of the annual event. We have that business group (now called the Greater Atlantic City Chamber) to thank for the Miss America Contest.

Was Charles Lindbergh's plane called The Spirit of Enterprise (the U.S. Chamber's tag line)? No, the flying bucket of bolts was, of course, The Spirit of St. Louis. The president of the St. Louis Chamber came up with the name in order to promote the great river city. And why should Lindbergh object? The chamber president also raised most of the money for the aircraft.

And who sent out the promotional brochure that enticed the first movie producer to southern California in 1907? It was the Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce. In nearby Hollywood a chamber was later active as well, helping re-fashion the famous Hollywood sign out of a decaying advertisement for a real estate development called "Hollywoodland."

Moreover, there's a guy in a suit present next to the glamorous celebrities who get their photos taken when their stars are set in the Hollywood sidewalk. Who is that business man? It's Leron Gubler, President of the Hollywood Chamber of Commerce, which invented and maintains the Walk of Fame.

Most of the thousands of things that local chambers have done and do are far removed from the big national issues that embroil the U.S. Chamber. Sure, most of the chambers in the country agree with and support the lion's share of the U.S. Chamber's positions. Although the goals are often the same, the priorities, issues, methods, leadership and, importantly, ownership are not.

Local chambers have shown themselves perfectly able to get into fights of their own, without orders from a non-existent chamber of commerce command center. So much of what we think of as America was facilitated or aided by those often forgotten, always resourceful groups known as local chambers of commerce. Whether it's the Golden Gate Bridge, Great Smoky Mountains National Park, the statue of Vulcan over Birmingham, commission and city manager forms of government, United Way-style giving, Baltimore's Inner Harbor, and so much more – it was local chambers that led the way.

The U.S. Chamber was fighting for business and free enterprise principles in Washington, but it was local chambers working "on the ground" that helped plant so many of these seeds across the nation. Each of the local chambers is vastly smaller than the U.S. Chamber, but collectively they have had a large impact. As in so many things, it has been the local organizations, not merely the national ones that have shaped this country's enterprise culture.

Create, practice and use a description of yourself and your work that can be said in 30 seconds or less. Know how to describe your work in one or two sentences. (This is commonly known as an Elevator Speech because it reflects what you can say in the time it takes to get from the ground floor to the top floor in an elevator.)

Listen more than you talk. Remember that there is nothing more flattering than someone who listens carefully and shows sincere interest in other people. Ask questions and listen to the responses so that you begin to understand the person.

Once you have someone's business card, make sure you follow up with them within 24 hours of the event. If there's an obvious win-win connection with someone you've met at an event, call them up and invite them to lunch to explore the connection further.





## State Changes Required Posters/Pamphlets Employers Must Use.

Are there any changes to the required posters and pamphlets for 2011?

Yes. Once again there was a change to a required poster and pamphlet during the year. These changes were to the workers' compensation poster and pamphlet. The requirement that employers display the new poster and give an updated pamphlet to new employees went into effect on October 8, 2010.

#### Updates for 2011.

For 2011, the following poster has changed:

• The Safety and Health Protection on the job (CalOSHA) poster has updated contact information.

In addition, the following pamphlets have been updated for 2-11.

- State Disability Insurance Pamphlet.
- Unemployment Insurance Pamphlet.

The State disability Insurance pamphlet must be given to all new hires

And to all employees who take a leave of absence for pregnancy disability, or any non-occupational illness or injury.

The Unemployment Insurance pamphlet must be given to employees who are terminated or who quit.

Through the CalChamber Store, employers can order the 2011 Required Notices Kit – all 16 State and Federal required employee notices on one space-saving poster, plus all five required employee pamphlets, updated as necessary for 2011 in packs of 20.

#### **Poster Project**

Also available for purchase is the Poster Project service, ensuring customers will receive a new poster at no additional charge if there are any mandatory changes in state or federal employment law posting requirements during the calendar year.

Here a few tips: Partner with other online services to offer deals to customers. Use those technologies properly so that a great deal doesn't turn into a money-losing horror for your business.

Create a mobile website. More and more, customers are using their mobile devices for both business and entertainment purposes, such as locating local restaurants and hotels. Make sure that your website displays well on mobile devices. If consumers have to scroll up and down or left and right several times to view your site, you are likely to lose sales.

List your business on major local search engines, including Google Places and Yelp. When someone types "flower shop" and enters his or her ZIP code or city, does your flower shop appear within the top results? Improve your search results organically by including on your website lots of content and links for search engines to index. The more content and links, the higher your search engine ranking. You can also purchase keywords to ensure that your website is listed when those keywords are typed into the search engine.

Leverage social media. Users of Foursquare check in to an establishment to earn points. Twitter is an emerging venue for paid local advertising. Facebook has developed a solution that enables local businesses to engage with local customers who check in. The local marketing dimensions of social media platforms are growing.

Once you've interacted with customers, ask for their contact information. Get their e-mail addresses and cell phone numbers to send them targeted advertising and a regular e-newsletter. Do this only with permission.

Provide great customer service. It's the non-tech things that matter most. Greet each customer with a smile! When it comes to local search, marketing, and advertising, start slow, test, and experiment. After a short time, you'll be able to determine what works best for your business and gives you the highest ROI.
