Generating meaningful interactions in the classroom environment is a critical goal for students who are augmented speakers. The Developmental Individual-Difference Relationship-Based Model, also known as Floortime™, provides an excellent framework for creating meaningful augmentative / alternative communication (AAC) interventions in the classroom.

This workshop will provide a foundation for understanding the Floortime[™] model and will illustrate how the use of a Floortime[™] framework can address several of the components of communicative competence as discussed by Light and Binger (1997) in their seminal work entitled *Building Communicative Competence with Individuals who use Augmentative and Alternative Communication*. Video examples of interventions will show how AAC and Floortime[™] can be combined successfully. Attendees will learn how to implement Floortime[™] strategies in the classroom and provide students using AAC with opportunities for novel interactions with their peers and classroom staff while also building a strong foundation for expressive language development.
