### **HOW TO REGISTER**

- 4. Return both forms to your ESOL Teacher by May 2, 2014.

#### Attendance

Regular and punctual attendance is mandatory. Students planning vacation trips at any time during the summer term should not enroll, as there will be NO EXCUSED ABSENCES FOR SUCH TRIPS. The only excused absence is a personal illness or death in the immediate family. An accumulation of three (3) absences will place the student in a position of being dropped from classes. There will be no early dismissal at the end of the term. Attendance on the final day of classes is required for course credit. Students will be expected to BE IN CLASS ON TIME. Three tardies in a class will constitute one unexcused absence. (3 Tardies = 1 Unexcused Absence!)

### **Dress**

A neat and well groomed appearance is required for registration and attendance. The NISD dress and grooming standards are to be followed.
