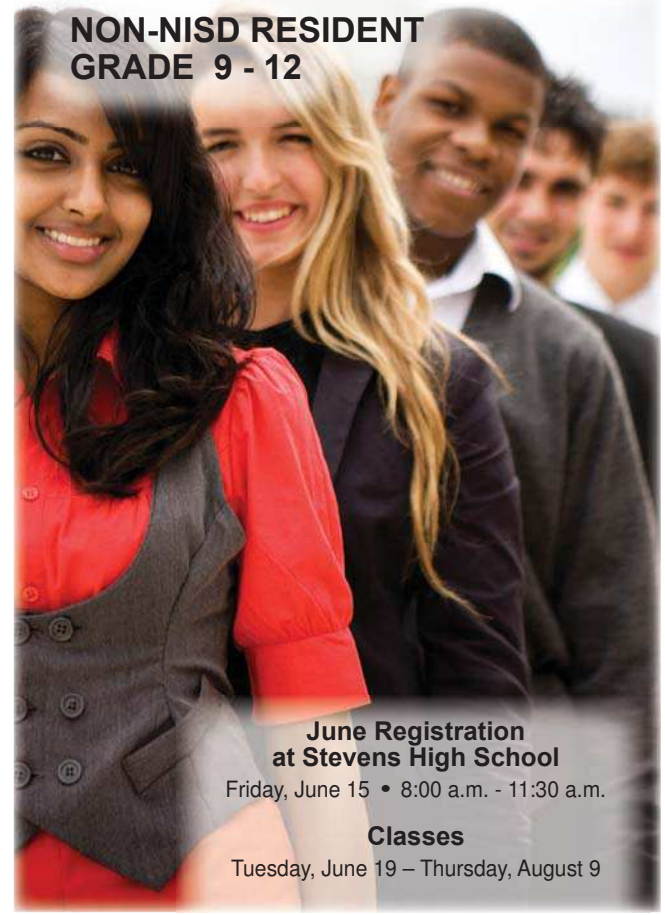

Registration

Registration is by application which must be completed in full. However, students must still register and pay tuition at the designated times before entering class.

June Registration times: Friday, June 15 for Non-NISD resident students from 8:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m. at Stevens High School.

Students not present at the designated time will register Tuesday, June 19 from 12 Noon – 2:00 p.m. Students may register late at this time without penalty, however, LONG WAITING LINES SHOULD BE ANTICIPATED AND AVAILABILITY OF CLASSES CANNOT BE GUARANTEED.

Non-Resident Tuition - Fees - Refunds

Tuition is due in full at registration. Refunds, less a non-refundable processing fee of \$25.00 will be given through June 28, 2012 for summer semester one and July 26, 2012 for summer semester two.

Lab Fees

A lab fee of \$7.50 sem. or \$15.00 for a full credit will be assessed for all science classes.

High School Courses

The following courses are offered to Non-NISD Resident students for a tuition of \$165.00 per semester or \$330.00 for a full course. These courses will be scheduled during morning sessions.

If a course is taken for a ½ unit (one semester), the semester dates will be June 19 - July 16 for Sem. 1 Part A, or July 17 - August 9, 2012 for Sem. 2 Part B, morning session only. (7:30am-12:45pm)

Dress

A neat and well-groomed appearance is a requirement for registration and attendance. The NISD dress and grooming regulations are to be followed. For example, shorts, skorts, bagging/sagging pants and body piercing jewelry are not permitted.

Attendance

Regular and punctual attendance is mandatory. Students planning vacation trips at any time during the summer term should not enroll as there will be NO EXCUSED ABSENCES FOR SUCH TRIPS. The only excused absences are for personal illness or a death in the immediate family. An accumulation of 3 absences will place the student in a position of being dropped from classes. There will be no early dismissal at the end of the term. ATTENDANCE ON THE FINAL DAY OF CLASSES IS REQUIRED FOR COURSE CREDIT. Students who are tardy miss instruction time and cause a major disturbance. Three tardies will be counted as one unexcused absence.

Conduct

It is expected that all students will conduct themselves in a respectful manner. Students are expected to follow all policies, rules, and regulations of the Northside School District.

Qualifications

All students who register for Summer School must have the approval of their principal or counselor in order to certify that the program planned will meet their individual needs.

Transportation

Bus transportation from Warren, Clark, Jay, Taft, Brennan, Brandeis, Marshall, O'Connor, and Holmes to Stevens HS will be provided if a sufficient number of students sign up at registration. Buses will run before school, and returning at the end of the morning classes, leaving Stevens at 1:00 p.m. Bus cards may be purchased in blocks of 15 rides for \$30.00 or 30 rides for \$60.00. The fee for the entire summer is \$120.00. **NISD buses will not run after the 1:15 p.m.- 4:00 p.m. high school class.**
