Results may include helpful videos or diagrams.	Go to www.lili.org, Select the image for Consumer Health Complete at the bottom of the window. Free for Idaho residents. Enter your ZIP Code and request information to get access.
The Beehive – Health http://www.thebeehive.org/health	Information about paying for healthcare, finding a doctor, and healthy living along with other content to find answers to health-related questions.	
Medline Plus http://www.nlm.nih.gov/medlineplus/	A free service for all, it has information about diseases and wellness information written in an easy-to-understand style. Includes videos and interactive tools to help learn more about conditions and procedures for treatment.


