



Important Session Topic Information

Hitting: Emphasis on the fundamentals of the swing and swing breakdown. We will go into detail about the mental aspect of hitting and approach to at bats.

Pitching: Pitchers will work on fundamentals and pitch development. We will go over correct form for movement pitches and work on the mental approach to pitching. You must bring your own catcher.

Catching: Emphasis on footwork, receiving, blocking and throwing to all bases. We will also work on the mental approach for catchers.

<u>Defense</u>: Emphasis on the fundamentals of infield and outfield footwork and throwing techniques.

General Items to Bring:

Please come dressed for participation. Players must bring their own glove and bat and catchers must bring their gear. Wear gym shoes.
