

College Representative Sessions

Each year about 250 college representatives will visit Hinsdale South High School to talk with students. These visits occur throughout the year. Visiting with these representatives is a great way to learn more about colleges you are interested in.

The schedule is posted on the bulletin board outside the Guidance Office, available online, and regularly announced on the P.A. Sign up in the guidance office at least 24 hours ahead time to visit with college reps.

Questions To Ask College Reps

Admission

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| Am I eligible for admissions? | What high school course preparation is needed? |
| What tests are required? | What are the application procedures? |
| What are the deadlines? | What academic demands can I expect to find? |

Cost

- How much will it cost?
- What kind of financial aid is available and how do I apply?

Majors and study programs available

- Does the school offer the major I want?
- If I am undecided, can I have the chance to explore some areas of interest?
- Does the school have any kind of internship program, co-op program, etc?

Social life

- What is the dorm life like?
- What extracurricular activities are available?
- What do students do on the weekends?

Housing

- How difficult is it to get on-campus housing?
- What is the cost?
- How do I apply? Is it a separate process from the admission application?

Community College

- What are the advantages of starting at a community college?
- Will I be able to complete transferable prerequisites to my major field?
