

Hope Tax Credit and Other Taxpayer Relief Act of 1997 Reporting Requirements

Postsecondary educational institutions are required to file information returns with the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) and with the individual student. These reports will help you, or the person who may claim you as a tax dependent, to determine eligibility for income tax credits for your educational expenses. In general, postsecondary schools will have to complete a Form 1098-T, Tuition Payments, for each student who has paid tuition or related expenses for any course(s) during the previous calendar year. The report will be mailed to your home address once each year.

The IRS requires that each form 1098-T include the Social Security Number (SSN) or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number (ITIN) of the student attending the institution. *In order to comply with IRS reporting requirements and provide you with a 1098-T form for these potential tax savings, please provide your valid Social Security Number or Individual Taxpayer Identification Number in the space below.*

If you do not have a SSN, you may obtain one by completing form SS-5, *Application for Social Security Card* that is available from your local Social Security Administration. To apply for an ITIN (for individuals not eligible for a SSN), request IRS Form W-7, *Application for IRS Individual Taxpayer Identification Number*, by calling the IRS: 1-800-829-3676.
