Dr. Perrin is a primary care pediatrician with a lifetime of policy work and advocacy for children and adolescents, especially those with chronic conditions. A professor of pediatrics at Harvard Medical School, Dr. Perrin heads the Division of General Pediatrics at the MassGeneral Hospital for Children (MGH). He also founded and directed the MGH Center for Child and Adolescent Health Policy.

His research examines day-to-day issues of pediatrics: asthma, otitis media, children's hospitalization, health insurance and chronic illness and disabilities. He now leads the Clinical Coordinating Center for the national Autism Speaks Autism Treatment Network to improve care for children with autism and other developmental disorders.
