
# Focusing on the Future, Learning from the Past: Toward Full Citizenship for All

#### FOCUS OF THE DAY: CITIZENSHIP AND PERSON-CENTERED WORK

Large and small group sessions will focus on:

- Self-direction: Remembering the valued lessons of our past, honoring our present and embracing the future. What strategies do people need to move beyond financial and formal services towards meaningful roles and relationships in the community?
- Family and child-centered support: Hearing and listening to families of children with disabilities. Have we heard their voices? How can we improve?
- Listening, understanding and supporting people with complex behaviors: What expectations have shaped our services and supports?
- Learning from children and adults with Autism who challenge assumptions about sensory and movement differences: What do we need to do to support those individuals to be members of their communities? What lessons have we learned from their experiences?
- Quality: What to we know about what really matters when you are a person who lives with a disability? How can supports have a positive impact on a person's day to day life?
- Person-centered work: Have efforts around person-centered planning and support delivered life
  experience that result in individuals having opportunities to contribute to their community, develop a
  support network and relationships? Have we developed competencies to increase organizational
  capacities that result in citizenship?
