- 1. Period of Lease. The period of this housing lease is the summer 2012 semester.
- 2. Housing Application Fee. A non-refundable housing application fee of \$200.00 must be paid by Student prior to assignment of housing to Student. Students that resided on-campus during the Fall 11 and/or Spring 2012 Semester will not be required to pay a \$200 non-refundable application fee for Summer 2012 housing. (applicant initial) (parent initial)
- **3.** Cancellation. Residential Life considers only those applicants for release who have submitted the appropriate documentation, and for who continued hall/apartment/Suite residence would cause extreme hardship (financial, medical, death or change in marital status). There will be a \$300.00 fee per resident to break the Lease Agreement. _____ (applicant initial) _____ (parent initial)
- 4. Housing Rental Fee. Student is obligated to pay a housing rental fee to FVSU pursuant to this lease in the amount of \$_____ (as assigned). This rental fee covers summer semester 2012 and is payable as specified by FVSU housing regulations.
- 5. Assignment of Housing. FVSU retains full authority with respect to the assignment of specific housing to student although it agrees to consider student's preferences as one factor in determination of housing assignments.
- 6. **Required Campus Residence.** Student acknowledges that FVSU policy requires all full-time students with less than 60 credit hours, all athletes, and all scholarship recipients to reside on campus unless specifically exempted pursuant to university policies.
- 7. Meal Plan. Student further acknowledges that FVSU policy requires every occupant of campus housing to participate in the Wildcat Silver meal plan unless otherwise approved by FVSU.
- **8. Guarantor.** Student acknowledges that FVSU policy requires that his or her obligations pursuant to this lease must be guaranteed by a responsible adult acceptable to FVSU unless specifically exempted by FVSU policy.
- 9. Housing Policies and Regulations. Student agrees to abide fully with all FVSU housing policies and regulations in force at the time this lease is agreed to, as well as all revised housing policies and regulations placed into effect after this lease is agreed to so long as such revised policies and regulations are reasonable and posted in accordance with FVSU standing requirements. Violation of an FVSU housing policy or regulation may subject Student to FVSU disciplinary action pursuant to the FVSU Code of Student Conduct.
