K.5 <u>Bid Contract Award - Stone Creek: Central Office Relocation Project</u>

WHEREAS, on December 16, 2009, the Montville Township Board of Education ("Board") held a public bid opening for the award of a contract for the following project: New Board of Education Offices at Montville Old Town Hall ("Project"); and

WHEREAS, the lowest bid for the Project was submitted by Stone Creek, Inc. ("Stone Creek"), Lodi, New Jersey, with a base bid in the amount of One Million Six Thousand Dollars (\$1,006,000.00) and a bid for Alternate #1 (applying stucco finish system balance of building exterior and painting to match) in the amount of Twenty Eight Thousand Dollars (\$28,000.00) for a total contract price of One Million Thirty Four Thousand Dollars (\$1,034,000.00); and

WHEREAS, upon a review and analysis of Stone Creek's bid, the Board, upon consultation with its design professional, has determined Stone Creek to be the lowest responsive and responsible bidder; and

WHEREAS, Stone Creek agreed on February 1, 2010, upon the Board's request, to extend the period within which the Board could hold its bid for potential award through March 16, 2010; and

WHEREAS, the Board's counsel has determined Stone Creek's bid to be awardable.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that in accordance with the provisions of the Public School Contracts Law, N.J.S.A. 18A:18A-1 et seq., the Montville Township Board of Education hereby awards a contract for the New Board of Education Offices at Montville Old Town Hall Project to Stone Creek, Inc. for a total contract sum of **One Million Thirty Four Thousand Dollars (\$1,034,000.00)** consisting of the base bid and Alternate #1; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Business Administrator is hereby authorized to return the bid bonds to all but the three (3) lowest bidders; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Board's counsel is authorized to prepare the Contract for the Project, transmit same to Stone Creek, and obtain all documents required thereby; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that upon receipt of a fully executed Agreement, as well as the insurance certificate, bonds, and other documents required by the Contract, the Business Administrator is authorized to return the remaining bid bonds.
