## Devils 2012 Home Opener

The New Jersey Devils home opener may have been canceled by the NHL lockout, but that did not stop a group of dedicated Devils Fan Club members from taking a day trip to see the Albany Devils home opener on Saturday October 13, 2012. Ironically, the team they played was the Manchester Monarchs, the AHL team for the Los Angeles Kings, who The New Jersey Devils played in the Stanley Cup finals. With a start time of 5:00 it made for an easy return home after the game.

Fan club members Trudy Stetter, Mickie Stueben, Lorayne Matthews and I took off for a beautiful fall drive up to Albany to the Times Union Center. While waiting for the doors to open we ran into several other New Jersey Devils fans who also made the trip to Albany. As we walked through the gate we were treated to watch a game of indoor soccer being played by many of the Albany players warming up for the game. Players included fan favorites Mattias Tedenby, Jacob Josefson, Adam Larsson, and Jay Leach, the Albany captain. We were able to watch warm ups at ice level and what a treat it was to see Adam Henrique on the ice again. Henrique is one of the alternate captains, along with Tim Sestito.

It was great seeing so many other fan club members, seeing familiar names on the backs of jerseys (including Zajac but this time it was Darcy) and hearing the familiar voice of Matt Loughlin as the arena announcer. We apologize for the delay of this November *Burning Issues* which was in final draft the day before Sandy hit!

Our emotions have been running the gamut regarding hockey this year, from disappointment that there has been no season thus far, to anticipation upon the start-up of talks again between the owners and the players and the following excitement that the lockout might soon be in our rear view mirror. It seems we are back to disappointment for now, as the NHL has announced no games will be played through November 30th. We certainly hope they are able to negotiate a resolution to their differences soon.

Due to the lockout, the Executive Board of the Devils Fan Club voted to extend the date that membership renewals are due to November 15, 2012. After that date, people who have not renewed their membership for the current year will be dropped from the membership roll and will no longer receive the newsletter and other DFC communications.

Several DFC members and many New Jersey Devils fans made the trek to Albany to take in the Albany Devils’ home opener, which was the same day that the New Jersey Devils’ season was supposed to start. It was an exciting game, ironically against the Manchester Monarchs, the AHL team whose NHL team played the New Jersey Devils in the Stanley Cup finals last June. The Devils scored the first goal of the game in the first minute of play but were unable to hold on to the lead and ended up losing by a score of 2-1. It was disappointing for Devils fans, but it still felt good to see hockey being played this October.

Congratulations are in order to Mr. Lou Lamoriello who was inducted into the United States Hockey Hall of Fame in the recent class.

Please check our trips selections and see which ones are right for you. Reservations for all trips are required ASAP. Trips might be cancelled if the required reservations aren’t met, as non-refundable deposits are the norm these days. Seats are going quickly! Deposits for those trips not run due to the lockout will be completely refunded.

If there are still no hockey games to be played when the annual food, toy, and coat drives were scheduled to be held, please consider donating the items and/or time you would normally donate at a game to a local charity, church, food bank, or soup kitchen. We know times are tough out there for so many people and the holidays can underscore

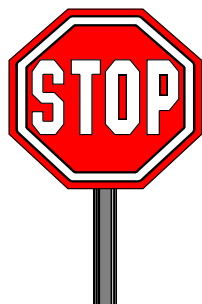

## 2012 - 2013 Membership Renewal

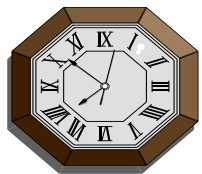

David Barr, Scott Stevens and Chris Terreri, in addition to Mr. Lamoriello, the New Jersey Devils President, CEO and General Manager on the concourse.

According to the "Red Alert" program Albany players Bobby Butler, Matt Corrente, Adam Henrique, Jacob Josefson, Adam Larsson, Jay Leach, Scott Parse, Tim Sestito, Mattias Tedenby, Alexander Urbom, Chad Wiseman and Steve Zalweski all have NHL experience. Henrique, Josefson, Larsson and Sestito played for the Devils during their 2012 playoff run, while Andrei Loktinov, Jordan Nolan, Slava Voynov, and Scott Parse (now on Albany) were on the Kings roster.

The Albany Devils were the first to score in the first period with a Chad Wiseman goal assisted by Raman Hrabarenka from Alexander Urbom but the Monarchs quickly tied the game 29 seconds later on a power play goal by David Kolomatis with Harri Pesonen off for hooking. Kolomatis scored his second power play goal less than 6 minutes later after the Devils took a too many men on the ice penalty. The Albany Devils had a few third period power play chances and it reminded me of the old saying, "the apple doesn't fall far from the tree" as we had all seen the NJ Devils struggle to score on their power plays too. The score remained at 2-1 with a Monarch win. Keith Kinkaid, in goal for Albany, made 25 saves on 27 shots and the winning goalie was Martin Jones making 22 out of 23 saves.

It was a fantastic experience and I would highly recommend a trip to Albany for all fans for that Devils game experience. The attendance was 5,072 and the Albany fans we spoke to were thrilled we made the ride from New Jersey. It's as close to the real thing during the lockout with lots of familiar players and chances are you will run into a few Devils fans you know.

Recently the DFC has identified six items found on the membership application that have led to the following problems: newsletters arrived late or were never received; our committee chairpersons were unable to contact members without checking a telephone information center (a time-consuming and costly endeavor); e-mail was returned as undeliverable; duplicate applications required refunds; and family membership required reprocessing. By taking a few steps, we can improve our delivery to you.

### **Address line:**

Please make sure your address includes Street, Avenue, Road, Place, etc.

If you have an apartment number or floor, please include it.

### **Zip Code + Four:**

The post office is requesting that the DFC include your zip code plus four number to expedite your mail delivery. If you don't know your zip plus four number, it can be found on your utility, telephone or banking statement. They include the extra four digits to decrease mailing costs. With your help, the DFC can do the same.

### **Telephone area code:**

Today, we have more than one area code in a geographic area. Please make sure that **YOUR** area code is current.

### **E-Mail address:**

The use of e-mail enables the DFC to bring members up-to-date with new or updated information. Most of our e-mail problems are caused by unreadable or misspelled e-mail addresses. Many letters and numbers look the same when hand written so **PLEASE PRINT CLEARLY**. Don't forget to contact us when you change your e-mail address.

### **Expiration Date:**

The top line on the right side of your printed mailing address label contains your membership expiration date. The top section of the newsletter electronic delivery email also contains your membership expiration date. Please **CHECK IT** before sending in your renewal. Note: we do not process renewals after the end of the regular season (usually mid April) until the start of our new fiscal year, July 1. There are no newsletters in July and August.

### **Family Membership:**

A family membership allows up to **TWO** adults at the same address. Should your application contain more than two adults, the application **WILL** be returned for correction, requiring a delay in activating your membership.
