The HCOP Summer Public Health Science Institute (SPHSI) targets rising Chicago land 6-12th grade students from Health Professions Shortage Areas. The SPHSI is offered at two different locations: UIC School of Public Health and Chicago State University. Accepted students who complete the application packet for UIC SPH will attend all classes at the UIC School of Public Health, which is located at 1603 W. Taylor. The entire program is FREE. The application is available on-line; go to uic.edu/sph, scroll down to CURRENT SPH INITIATIVES, click the link for HCOP Summer Public Health Science Institute, print the application. Students interested in attending class sessions at Chicago State should call (773) 995-3981.

The purpose of the SPHSI is to:

- Increase awareness of public health, its relevance to society and its career paths
- Better prepare students for college
- Standardized Test Preparation.
- Prepare and motivate students to take competitive courses such as Honors and AP
- Provide academic enrichment for mathematics, reading, writing, science, standardized test-taking strategies, social development/enhancement skills, field trips and research
- Provide workshops on how to compete for best scholarship offers; the cost of college
 education; time management; general financial aid; how to integrate interest in sports
 with excellent academic performance; visits to public health sites and local area hospitals
- Provide opportunities for students to interact with public health professionals and public health graduate students
- Provide opportunities for rising 12th grade students to participate in public health research

Additional Highlights:

- Rising 9-12th grade students are paid a stipend for their full participation
- Students attend classes from 9:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. Monday-Friday
- Priority will be given to students who attend a CPS Public Health Partner School

Eligibility:

- Must have a minimum GPA of 2.50
- Most recent test scores must be at grade level at minimum
- Must be interested in pursuing a career in public health or other health profession

Letter of Acceptance

Accepted students will receive a letter in the mail during the first week of May and will be invited to attend a mandatory orientation along with a parent/guardian.

In addition to student's involvement, an essential part of this program is the parental involvement. Parent(s)/guardian(s) must attend at least one parent network meeting during summer.
