**Application Instructions**

You must submit a completed EESHP Application Form in order to be considered for acceptance to the WTAMU REU program. Additionally, you must provide:

- 1) a two page essay (double spaced) that focuses on the development of your interest in ecology and the environment and your current professional interests and goals (which need not be in ecological or environmental research)
- 2) a copy of your transcripts (the copy need not be official but all persons who are accepted to the program will need to provide an official transcript)
- 3) a letter of recommendation from a faculty member at your home institution.

Applicants should meet the following criteria: 1) a US citizen or permanent resident, who is an undergraduate student majoring in biology, environmental science, or related field; 2) sophomore standing with a GPA of 3.0 in all science courses completed (special consideration if science GPA < 3.0 but improvement indicated); 3) 8 hours in biology and lab coursework and an additional 4 hours in related science coursework completed or equivalent laboratory and/or field experiences; 4) intellectual curiosity, enthusiasm, and commitment as revealed by essays. Special consideration will be give to applicants from institutions with limited research opportunities.
