A BRIEF HISTORY OF Grove City Country Club

On December 3, 1903 the Barmore Lake Association was formed for the purpose of maintaining a public park and facilities for skating, boating, trotting and other athletic sports as well as clubs for the preservation of fish and game. With little income over the years, debts began to mount. The Barmore Lake Association owed a mortgage of \$2,900.00 by 1915. It became apparent that a change in ownership was needed for the property.

In June 1917 (one month after the United States declared war in the World War I) 107 subscribers signed the charter for a new "Grove City Country Club" and the transition of ownership was complete. In 1918 the dues for Club Membership were \$5.00 per year. During World War II, the area now known as the picnic grounds was an orchard and members planted "Victory Gardens" along the driving range.

There were numerous property acquisitions throughout the years that culminated in the expansion of the golf course in the 1990s. In 1996, the "new nine" was added. Designed by John Ponko this project completed the Club's transition to an 18-hole golf course.
