### TAPPI/ PIMA Student Summit Proposal

The TAPPI/PIMA Student Summit is an annual event designed to provide students interested in pulp, paper, packaging, and allied industries direct interaction with industry leaders and gain valuable information about employment and career development within the industry. The Student Summit is an excellent venue for advanced undergraduate and graduate students to learn about opportunities after graduation as well as some of the key challenges and opportunities existing in the industry today. The TAPPI/PIMA Student Summit is the only event that brings students from the paper and packaging schools together to reinforce their interest in joining the industry. The students benefit from a highly subsidized registration fee. In order to make up the short fall TAPPI solicits companies for support.

This is the leading industry career fair event. At no other venue can you find this many paper and packaging students assembled together. For the past three years, the Student Summit has set attendance records with over 110 students attending. We expect to have at least that many again this year. The sponsorship opportunities below are designed to help your company gain greater name recognition with potential employees and provide a venue for you to interview for new talent onsite. Students in these programs enjoy five or six serious job offers upon graduation. This is your opportunity to rise above the crowd of other potential employers.

### Student Summit Overview

Since 2009 the Student Summit has had a record attendance of over 100 students from 13 schools. TAPPI has expanded the Student Summit's reach to include packaging schools. For the past three years the Summit has included a career fair and interview center to facilitate new talent for our industry. Also, students' efforts are reaching around the world, with students now visiting from TAPPI chapters abroad.

The Student Summit takes place on Martin Luther King weekend, with opening sessions starting in the afternoon on Saturday and lasting until noon on Monday. There is always a plant tour, engineering competition, and a fun group outing that is built into the schedule. Topics and sessions for the Student Summit include finance and investments, resume and interviewing skills, business etiquette, and project management. The sessions also include more technical topics such as

Nanotechnology, Printed Electronics, and the State of the Industry presentations. None of these topics are taught as part of their college curriculum.
