Code of Conduct Agreement

The Code of Conduct as stipulated in the Student Handbook applies to all parts of a study-travel course. During travel, moreover, these five points are particularly important:

1. General Behavior

Students must respect the people and property as well as the local, state, and national laws.

2. Drugs

Possession and consumption of any illegal drugs at any time is strictly prohibited. Faculty/administrators must be informed prior to departure of any prescription drugs, which must be carried in their original containers.

3. Alcohol

Alcoholic beverages are prohibited at University-sponsored activities regardless of age or local laws. Intoxication will not be tolerated under any circumstances.

4. Attendance

Students are required to attend all scheduled activities of the group.

5. Dress Code

Students must dress in attire appropriate for the particular activities planned and appropriate for the service work being performed, as determined by the administrative leaders. For this trip, dress guidelines include:

- A. For women: *No spaghetti straps, no midriffs, no mini skirts, no mini shorts, no flip-flops, sandals, or open-toed shoes at the service site.*
- B. For Men: *No hats in places of worship, no tank tops, flip-flops, sandals, or other open-toed shoes at the service site.*

Violations of any part of the Code of Conduct may result in the student's dismissal and being sent back to CLU **at his or her own expense**. And further judicial action may be taken.

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Trip Information

Service Agency/ Focus: This trip will be partnering with New City Parish (<http://www.newcityparish.org>), an urban coalition of 9 ELCA congregations in LA, Inglewood, and Compton California. The NCP Urban & Cross Cultural experience will allow for our group to explore a variety of urban poverty issues including hunger, homelessness, youth outreach, health, worker justice, and prisoner re-entry.

Cost: \$200- this will include transportation to and from LA (leaving from CLU), food, housing, and any costs associated with service projects.

Dates: August 21-25, 2012

Group Size: This trip is open to 12 students.

Lodging: We will be staying at a local church within the city. You can expect to spend nights on cots or the floor, sleeping bags are highly recommended.

Transportation: We will be leaving from CLU to LA at 10am on Wednesday, August 21st and will return to campus on Saturday, August 25th in the evening.
