On Friday, **June 7th**, **2013**, Urbana High School is hosting a Science, Math and Technology Career Day for our student body. The event will begin at 7:45 a.m. and end at 2:05 p.m. Set up will begin at 7:15 a.m. This project will give approximately 1000 Urbana students a chance to learn about numerous science and technology careers. Approximately 150-200 students may attend your sessions throughout the day.

It would be greatly appreciated if you would share your knowledge with us. If you or someone you know has the time and extensive knowledge of your career field, please fill out the enclosed registration form and return it to Urbana High School. In order to give us time to inform the student body of the presenters attending, please **email** the registration form to us by May 18th.

You will be assigned a **classroom** for the day. We would like you to prepare about a 20-25 minute presentation. You will deliver that same presentation for eight sessions throughout the day. We expect approximately 20-30 students per session. We wish for you to share pertinent information about your daily work activities, your education, and any other related careers within your area or anything you believe may be of interest to the students. During the day, students will visit the various classrooms allowing you to formally share this information about your career through discussion, videos, handouts, brochures, packets, etc. Computers and Internet hookups will be available; feel free to bring your own laptop set-up. We can provide electrical outlets and extension cords, TV/VCR's and digital projectors are available upon request. I may be able to provide internet access through a guest pswd if needed. Parking is often challenging, so please park along the fence in front of the school. The front parking closest to the sidewalk is reserved for afternoon buses. A student will greet you in the main office and will be available to assist you with carrying any materials if necessary.

A one-hour lunch will be provided courtesy of Urbana High School. Please return the attached registration form as soon as possible if you are able to attend. Your participation will make our 13th Annual STEM Career Day a successful and informational experience for all.
