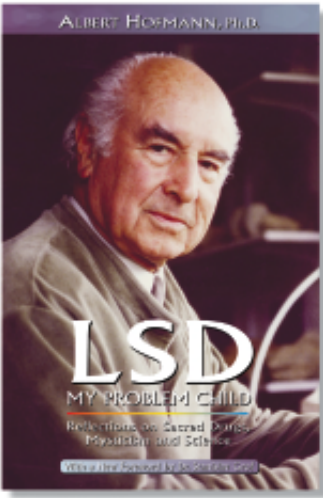

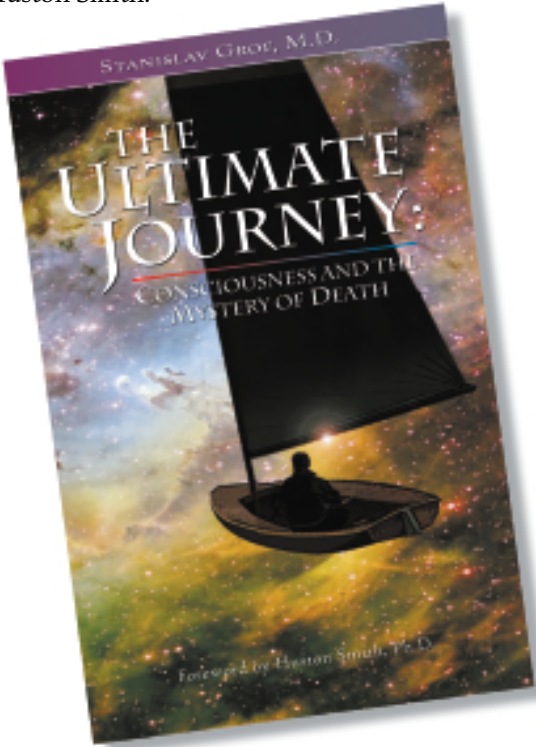

In honor of Dr. Albert Hofmann's 100th birthday, MAPS has republished the English edition of Dr. Hofmann's memoir, *LSD: My Problem Child — Reflections on Sacred Drugs, Mysticism, and Science*. New to this MAPS edition are 16 pages of color illustrations, a new introduction from the author, a foreword by LSD psychotherapist Stanislav Grof, M.D, and an index.
Out of print in the U.S. for years, this is the fascinating account of LSD's discovery, its brief status as a promising psychiatric research medicine, its transformation into a recreational drug, and its potential to catalyze spiritual experiences. Dr. Hofmann also tells the story of his adventures in Mexico with Gordon Wasson, where he sought out sacred mushrooms (later isolating psilocybin as their active component) and *salvia divinorum*.

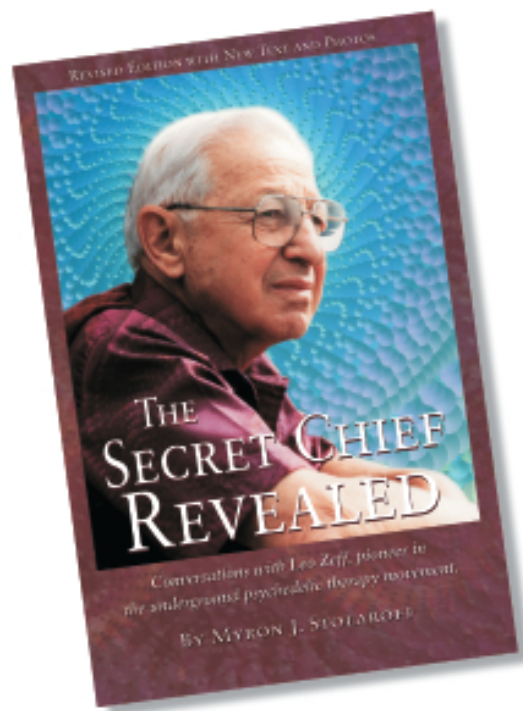

Dr. Stanislav Grof, author of *LSD Psychotherapy* and the originator of Holotropic Breathwork, offers a wealth of perspectives on how we can enrich and transform the experience of dying in our culture. This 356 page book features 40 pages of images, 24 in color, and a foreword by Huston Smith.



In *The Ultimate Journey*, Dr. Grof discusses his own patients' experiences of death and rebirth in psychedelic therapy, investigates cross-cultural beliefs, paranormal and near-death research, and argues that, contrary to the predominant Western perspective, death is not necessarily the end of consciousness.

Dr. Grof is a psychiatrist with over forty years experience of research into non-ordinary states of consciousness and one of the founders and chief theoreticians of transpersonal psychology. He is the founder of the International Transpersonal Association, and has published over 140 articles in professional journals.

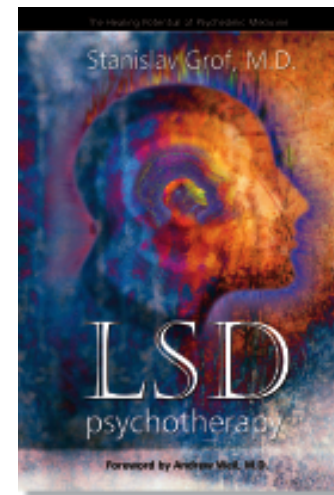

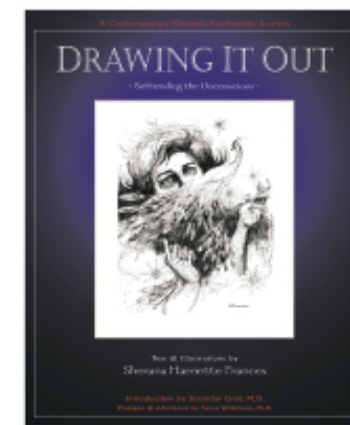

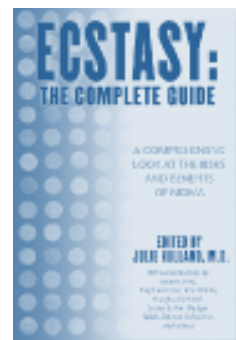

Imprisoned in Auschwitz for two years, having eluded death by the narrowest of margins, the man known as Ka-Tzetnik 135633 survived the Holocaust to discover that survival alone would not end his torment. For 30 years, through nightly dreams of terrifying intensity, the writer remained captive to the horrors of Auschwitz. Finally in 1976 he sought help from Professor Bastiaans, the Dutch psychiatrist who first recognized Concentration Camp Syndrome and successfully treated camp survivors with a therapy involving doses of LSD. Shivitti is a memoir of that experience, and reading it may change your life.
