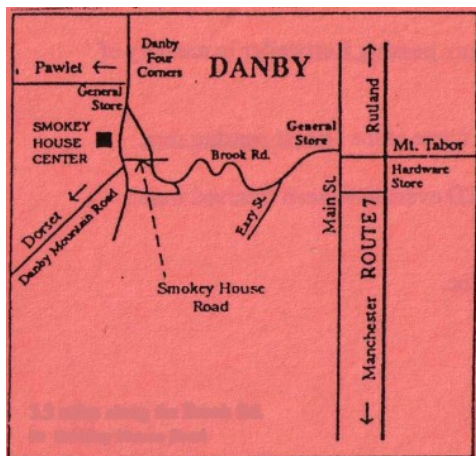

DIRECTIONS TO THE TEST SITE

From Manchester or Rutland, Vermont, take U.S. Route 7 to Danby. Turn onto Mount Tabor Avenue (left coming from Manchester; right coming from Rutland).

Turn right at South Main Street and then immediately left onto Brook Road (by Nichols Store).



Proceed on Brook Road for approximately 3.3 miles. Look for the sign for Smokey House Center opposite a maple sugar house. Turn left onto Smokey House Road and follow the signs to the test site.

There is a small general store in Danby. Bring what you need. This is a very rural area.

Due to aggressive local law enforcement, entrants are advised to comply with all traffic laws.

A written **AKC CERTIFICATION** must accompany the entry for any dog that has not previously passed an American Kennel Club Tracking Dog Test.

DRAWING FOR ENTRIES will be held on Thursday, October 3, 2013 at 6:30 pm. at Sal's South Restaurant, 15 South Main Street, Wallingford, VT 05773. Preference in the drawings will be given to dogs without titles, otherwise the drawings will be completely random. There will be an alternate list with positions assigned according to the order in which they were drawn. The Test Secretary will notify all entrants of the results of the drawing by mail and/or email if a valid email address has been provided. The Worker Option draw will not be in effect.

WITHDRAWALS AND ENTRY FEE REFUNDS: If an entry withdraws between the closing date and the test date, and is replaced by an alternate, the entry fee and certification will be refunded. Withdrawals must be made in writing to the Test Secretary. Any entrant who does not run in the test, but is replaced by an alternate who participates in the test, will have their entry fee and certification returned. Entry fees will not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Judge, or barred from competition by action of the Test Committee. Note: Tests may be canceled or rescheduled in the event of extreme weather conditions.

BITCHES IN SEASON will be allowed to participate after all other entrants have been tested. They will be allowed on the tracking fields only immediately prior to the running of their tracks.

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
2. The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
3. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e, age division, color division, weight division.
4. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name.
