- Copy of Rating Decision/Award Letter issued by the Federal VA
- Copy of DD-214 or Separation Papers
- Photo ID

When your application is processed you will be mailed a Disabled Veteran State Park/Forest/Trail Pass Identification card. Present your identification card along with a photo ID at any state park or forest or trail for free daily admission. Fee waiver does not apply to nightly camping fees or other non-admission fees.
