- **5.** Interview sessions will be arranged by WCE staff after an initial review of applications. You will be notified via email.

#### A Note on Interviews and Acceptance:

The WCE Admission Committee will notify those students who pass the initial review and are invited for an interview. Interviews will not be granted at the request of the applicant. All accepted students will be contacted directly and informed of their acceptance to the program. Acceptance is contingent upon a review of a student's fall semester grades.
