

### **Available Housing:**



Frances Dearing Hay Hall, named in honor of Mrs. Samuel B. Hay, was opened for occupancy in the fall of 1966. It houses first and second year men.



Martin Luther King, Jr. Hall was completed in 1968. It is similar in design to Williams Hall and provides housing for male students.



John Knox Hall was constructed in 1939 as a student nurses' residence. This building bears the name of the founder of the Presbyterian Church in Scotland. Renovated in 1994, John Knox was rededicated in 1995 as a men's residence hall, housing upperclassmen and Harte Honors College students.



Joseph D. Roulhac Hall is a suite-style building completed in 2000. It houses women. The building contains laboratories and a food court. The hall was named in honor of Joseph D. Roulhac, a graduate of Stillman, a former Board of Trustee member, and the first African-American judge in Akron, Ohio.



**Frank H. M. Williams Hall** was completed in 1968; the building was named in honor of an alumnus, philanthropist, and former trustee of Stillman. It houses male students.



Hallie Paxon Winsborough Hall was constructed by the Women of the Presbyterian Church in 1922; and renovated- in 1966 and 1987. It provides housing for senior women. This building bears the name of Mrs. Hallie Paxon Winsborough who was Secretary of Women's Work from 1912-1929.



Marie Lundy Wynn Hall was named in honor of the wife of the college's fourth president, Dr. Cordell Wynn (1981-1997). This is a female hall that houses Harte Honors College students, honor students, and upper-class women.
